

CANCELATION OF 2017 SUMMER MEETINGS OF THE FACULTY COUNCIL

In accordance with the rules of the Faculty Council, Secretary Alan W. Friedman has accepted the recommendation of the Executive Committee that the regular meetings of the Faculty Council scheduled for June 19, July 17, and August 21 be canceled, with the understanding that special meetings will be called if warranted.

If no objection is filed with the Office of the General Faculty by the date specified below, the legislation will be held to have been approved by the Faculty Council. If an objection is filed within the prescribed period, the legislation will be presented to the Faculty Council at its meeting on May 1, 2017. The objection, with reasons, must be signed by a member of the Faculty Council.

To be counted, a protest must be received in the Office of the General Faculty by April 17, 2017.
